## **CAMPUS RESOURCES**

Disability Resource Center – accommodations and services for UGA students with disabilities

<u>Certificate in Diversity and Inclusion (For Faculty and Staff)</u> - engages UGA faculty and staff in building the capacity to contribute to and sustain a diverse and inclusive environment

Equal Opportunity Office – responsible for ensuring that UGA complies with all applicable laws and policies regarding discrimination on the basis of race, sex (including sexual harassment and pregnancy), gender identity, sexual orientation, ethnicity or national origin, religion, age, genetic information, disability or veteran status

<u>GLOBES (LGBT Faculty & Staff Organization)</u> - a diverse organization of faculty, staff, and administrators whose mission is to advocate for, develop, and nurture UGA's LGBTQ communities

<u>Graduate and Professional Scholars (GAPS)</u> – utilize the collective resources available to the organization, including members, alumni and friends, for the creation and maintenance of an academic environment that is conducive to the successful matriculation of historically underrepresented graduate and professional students through the University of Georgia

<u>Graduate Pride</u> - a group for graduate and professional students of the University of Georgia who identify as LGBT to build community

<u>Institutional Diversity</u> – provides institutional leadership to the focused effort to enhance and maintain a diverse and inclusive environment for learning, teaching, research and service at UGA

<u>International Student Life</u> – enhances the student-learning environment through programs and services that internationalize the campus experience

<u>LGBT Resource Center</u> - an inclusive and sustainable space of self-discovery for the LGBT community within UGA, and a space by which all members of the campus community can engage and explore issues associated with sexual and gender identities

<u>Multicultural Services and Programs</u> – works to create an inclusive campus environment by supporting the development and affirming the overall experiences of all students, particularly multicultural students

<u>NAACP (UGA Chapter)</u> - ensures the political, educational, social, and economic equality of rights of all persons and works to eliminate race-based discrimination

<u>Office of Global Engagement</u> – provides support and services for global education, immigration and international initiatives

Quiet Reflection Room – room 349 in the Tate Student Center can be used for quiet reflection, meditation, or prayer

<u>Safe Space</u> – training for faculty, staff, and students who are interested in learning about gender and sexual identity, homophobia, heterosexism, and how they can provide support and work toward being an ally for the LGBT community

<u>Student Affairs Diversity Fund</u> - support initiatives that promote understanding, inclusion, and acceptance within the University of Georgia community

<u>Student Veteran's Resource Center</u> – serves as a central location for information about the university's services for student veterans while also offering support, advocacy and a convenient location for student veterans to gather throughout the day

<u>UGA Career Center Diversity Resources</u> – resources that will enhance the career development of underrepresented students

<u>UGA Ombudspersons</u> - designated individuals who serve as independent, neutral, and informal resources for UGA students, faculty, and staff

<u>Women's Resources</u> – promotes awareness and access to women's services, organizations, programs, and events across campus, and provides a hub for safety information, community support, and advocacy for women
