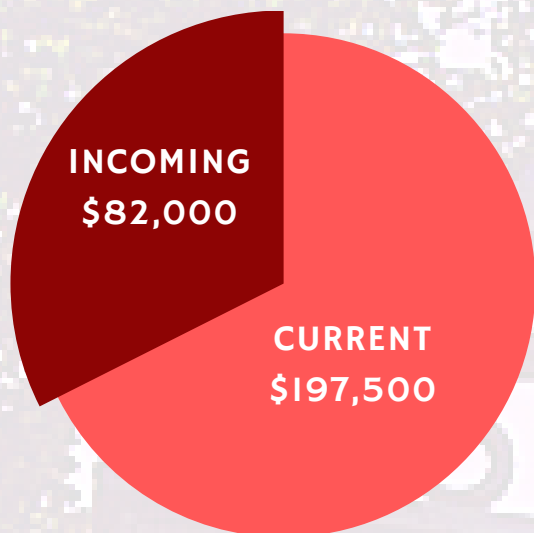


PharmD SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED FOR 2020-2021

OFFICE OF STUDENT AFFAIRS

Total Scholarship Amount

\$279,500



For the 2020-2021 academic year, the University of Georgia College of Pharmacy awarded scholarships totaling \$279,500 to both incoming and current students.

32% of the scholarships awarded were based on financial need.

In total, there were 88 scholarship funds available for current students, and 28 scholarship funds available for incoming students.

Scholarship Amounts

SCHOLARSHIPS RANGED FROM \$1000 TO \$5000

The College of Pharmacy awarded scholarships to students, ranging from \$1000 to \$5000.

Four current students and **one** incoming student received the highest amount.



Incoming PharmD Students

AVERAGE AWARD: \$2,050

41 incoming students received scholarships, totaling \$82,000. Scholarships ranged from \$1000 to \$5000.

The average award was \$2,050. These scholarships will help offset costs associated with attendance.



Current PharmD Students

AVERAGE AWARD: \$1,795

A total of \$197,500 was awarded to 110 scholarship recipients among currently enrolled students. There were a total of 181 applicants; 61% of the applicants received funding.

181 students applied for scholarships for the 2020-2021 academic year. *The average award was \$1,795.*
