*At a minimum, experiential site policies will be followed. Any more stringent site policies will supersede the below.

- <u>Do not report to your site</u>. Contact your Regional Coordinator and preceptor immediately to determine next steps.
- In the interim, follow <u>CDC Guidelines</u> to stay home, separate yourself from other people, monitor symptoms, and get tested if you haven't already.
- 3. ALL POSITIVE TESTS must be reported in <u>DawgCheck</u>, to Dr. Do, and to your Regional Coordinator immediately (*this includes during <u>vacation blocks and scheduled breaks</u>).

Regional Coordinator will:


- Work with student and preceptor/site to determine when student can be cleared to return based on site policies.
- Work with preceptor to ensure any missed time is adequately made up.



Have you been in close contact with someone who has been diagnosed with or tested positive for COVID-19?





- 1. Do not need to quarantine.
- 2. Follow prevention measures.
 - Wear a mask.
 - Social distance.
 - Avoid crowds.
 - Wash hands frequently.
- 3. Should get tested 3-5 days after exposure.
- 1. Contact your Regional Coordinator and preceptor *immediately* to determine next steps.
- 2. Monitor for symptoms.
- 3. Site policies will be followed.

Individuals are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second shot in a 2-dose series (e.g., Pfizer or Moderna vaccines) or 2 weeks after a single-shot vaccine (e.g., Johnson's Janssen vaccine).
