COVID-19 DECISION TREE



For College of Pharmacy Faculty, Staff and Supervisors

YOU HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT FOR COVID-19? Are you sick and suspect that you might have COVID-19 but do not yet have test results? 1. Follow CDC Guidelines to stay home for at least 5 days and separate yourself from others regardless of vaccination status. If after 5 days, you are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication, and your symptoms are improving, or you never had symptoms, you may end isolation after day 5. Do not need to Wear a high-quality mask through day quarantine. Call your healthcare provider for guidance if needed. Isolate and wait for test results. 3. Notify your supervisor. If your results are positive, follow CDC's isolation recommendations (shown on the left). If your results are negative, you can end your isolation.

- Supervisor will work with faculty/staff to determine when they should return to campus based on CDC Guidelines.
- Supervisors may consult Dr. Michael Bartlett (mgbart@uga.edu) to determine if further action is needed (i.e., facility cleaning).

CDC RECOMMENDATIONS ON EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

If you were exposed to COVID-19, wear a highquality mask for 10 days and get tested on day 6. Quarantine is not required.
