**ARE YOU EXPERIENCING ANY SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19 OR  
DO YOU HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT FOR COVID-19?**

I have symptoms and/or a positive test.



1. Follow [CDC Guidelines](#) to stay home, separate yourself from other people, monitor symptoms, and get tested if you haven't already.
2. Report positive test to [DawgCheck](#) and follow recommendations from DawgCheck.
3. Contact healthcare provider for guidance if needed.
4. Notify your supervisor.



Supervisor will work with faculty/staff to determine when [return-to-campus criteria](#) are met and the employee can be cleared to return.

Supervisors will communicate with COP COVID-19 Operational Leadership Team (COLT) to determine if further action is needed (i.e., additional reporting, facility cleaning). The primary COLT contact for supervisors is Dr. Michael Bartlett ([mgbart@uga.edu](mailto:mgbart@uga.edu)).

Individuals are considered fully vaccinated 2 weeks after their second shot in a 2-dose series (e.g., Pfizer or Moderna vaccines) or 2 weeks after a single-shot vaccine (e.g., Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine).

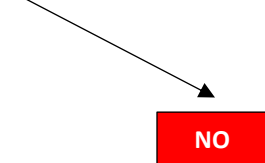
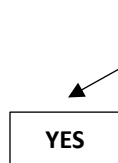

3. Should get tested 3-5 days after exposure.
