

COVID-19 DECISION TREE



For College of Pharmacy *Faculty, Staff and Supervisors*

DO YOU HAVE A POSITIVE TEST RESULT FOR COVID-19?

YES

1. Follow [CDC Guidelines](#) to stay home for 5 days and separate yourself from others regardless of vaccination status.
 - If after 5 days you are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication, and your symptoms are improving, or you never had symptoms, you may end isolation after day 5.
 - Wear a high-quality mask through day 10.
2. Call your healthcare provider for guidance if needed.
3. Notify your supervisor.

- Supervisor will work with faculty/staff to determine when they should return to campus based on CDC Guidelines.
- Supervisors may consult Dr. Michael Bartlett (mgbart@uga.edu) to determine if further action is needed (i.e., facility cleaning).

NO

Are you sick and suspect that you might have COVID-19 but do not yet have test results?

YES

- Isolate and wait for test results.
- If your results are positive, follow CDC's isolation recommendations (shown on the left).
 - If your results are negative, you can end your isolation.

NO

Do not need to quarantine.

CDC RECOMMENDATIONS ON EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

If you were exposed to COVID-19, wear a high-quality mask for 10 days and get tested on day 5. Quarantine is not required.
