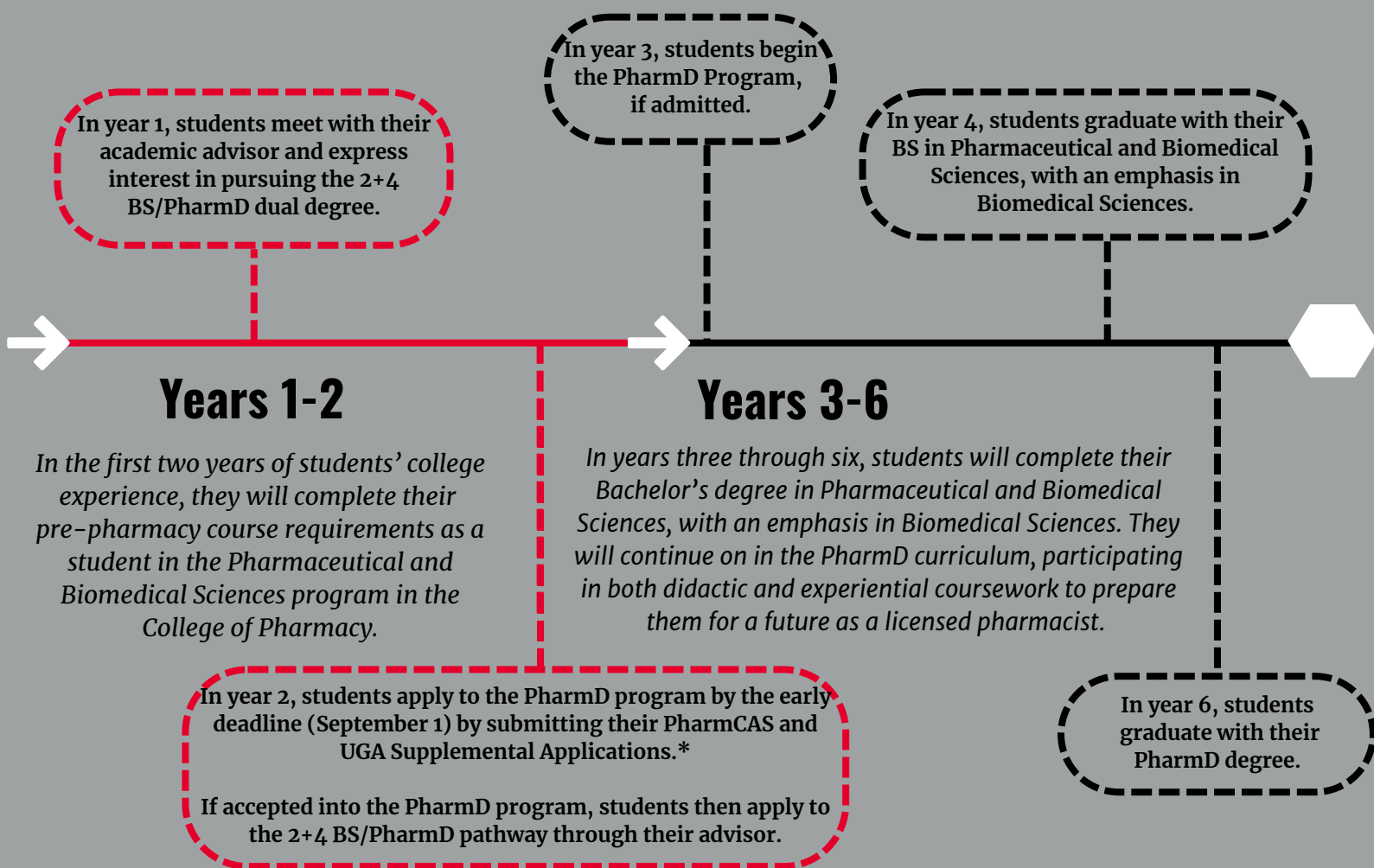

DUAL DEGREE PROGRAM

Students interested in pharmacy with a foundation in pharmaceutical and biomedical sciences have a guided pathway, which combines a Bachelor of Science in Pharmaceutical and Biomedical Sciences (BSPBS) with a Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD). The Pharmaceutical and Biomedical Sciences BS/PharmD program allows students to complete the program in six years. The goal of this degree is to create pharmacists who possess a deeper understanding of the pharmaceutical and biomedical sciences in order to enhance their ability to be part of the emerging healthcare team model.



*Students must have a 2.5 minimum prerequisite GPA to be eligible for an interview. Eligibility does not guarantee admission. Students also must complete a successful background check for admission.

WHY CHOOSE PHARMACY?

Pharmacists are the fourth highest paying professionals in the U.S., making a degree in pharmacy a sound investment, according to Glassdoor.

WHY CHOOSE UGA?

The UGA College of Pharmacy is ranked 15th in the nation by *U.S. News and World Report*.
