Students who matriculate between fall 2020 and fall 2024 are required to complete 11 hours of electives, and students who matriculate in fall 2025 and thereafter are required to complete 10 hours of electives as part of the PharmD curriculum.

POI = Permission of Instructor REQUIRED. **If a course requires POI, students must obtain permission directly from the INSTRUCTOR before registering for the course in ATHENA.**

Duplicate PHRM 5210 or 5980 Registration: If you plan to take two different PHRM 5210 or 5980 courses simultaneously in the Fall semester, add the first course to your schedule on Athena.
